Today's program starts with Nicolas de Grigny's Les Hymnes which he composed based on the Gregorian chant. A giant star of the French Classical Period, Grigny celebrates his 350th birth this year. In the second half of the program, we will perform Messiaen's "Mass of Pentecost," which is like a sound translation of biblical passages, 30 years after his death this year. In between, we will present the beautiful music of the oboe, which will fill the hall, accompanied by the organ.
